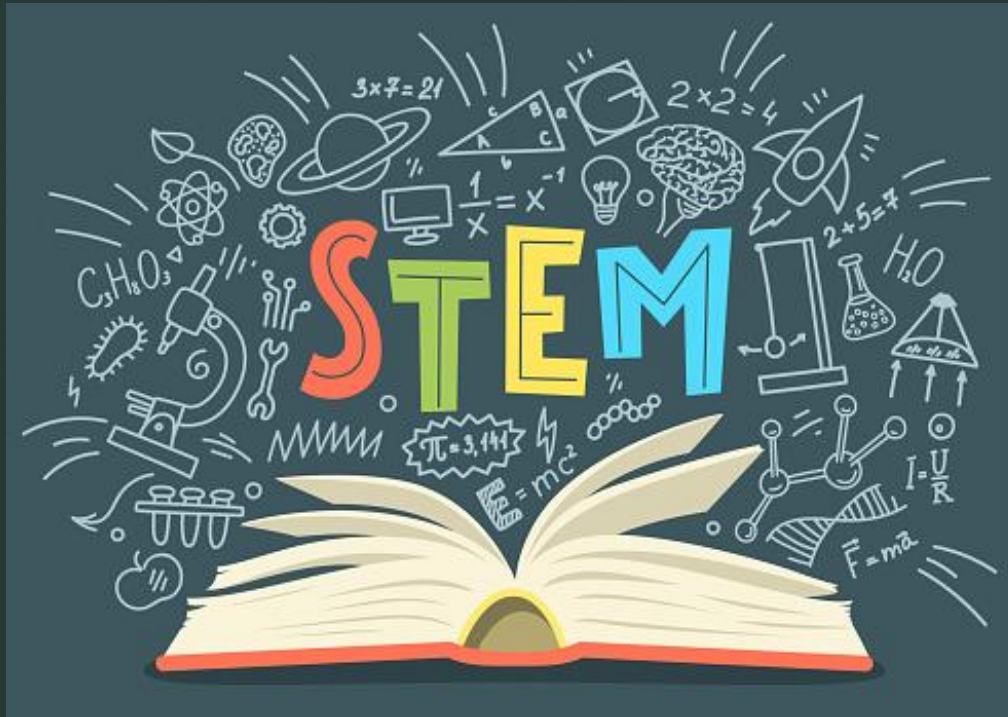
Advanced Courses

- Scores 1-5, July
- May convert to college credit, depending upon school, major, grade
